The proposed tax includes the uniform rate of tax (the "Statewide Uniform Rate") to be collected on all taxable property in the State and remitted to the State Treasurer pursuant to Amendment No. 74 to the Arkansas Constitution to be used solely for maintenance and operation of schools in the State. As provided in Amendment No. 74, the Statewide Uniform Rate replaces a portion of the existing rate of tax levied by this School District and available for maintenance and operation of schools in this District. The total proposed school tax levy of 43.7 mills includes 25.0 mills specifically voted for general maintenance and operation, 2.0 mills voted for dedicated maintenance and operation to be used for purchase of buses, make payments on revolving loans and make improvements and equip existing school facilities, and 16.7 mills voted for debt service previously voted as a continuing levy pledged for the retirement of existing bonded indebtedness. 
